- Be accepted into a College, University or Technical School for the fall semester of 2024.

Application Process:

- Applicant must provide a 500 1000 word essay based on the following criteria:
 - What does community service mean to you?
 - How do you feel your involvement in the community has benefited others?
 - How do you feel you can continue to contribute to the community?

Application Deadline:

All essays must be received no later than May 1st, 2024. Any entries received after the May 1st deadline will not be entered into the review process. Brandywine Heights High School Staff will review all the information provided for accuracy. The Scholarship committee will review the essays and a winner will be awarded during the senior awards presentation.
